Discussion points:

- Updates
 - Public consultation on DSA runs from June 2-September 8. More info: <https://ec.europa.eu/digital-single-market/en/news/consultation-digital-services-act-package>
 - Commission confirmed the online platforms will remain on the agenda for 2021/2022
 - In Autumn, as a replacement for platform summit, the Commission will organize a series of consultations to gather evidence
- Work streams
 - Work streams were presented
 - The final report will encompass three work streams 1) Access to good quality work, 2) Social protection, rights and benefits and 3) Skills and career development. However, during the roundtable discussions the first two work streams will be discussed simultaneously considering their interrelatedness.
- Project timeline

- The month of November will have 2 project meetings so we can meet the final project deadline
- In December we will have an internal workshop with the Commission during which the executive summary of the report will be presented
- Any amendments to the timeline will be discussed with the project members beforehand
- Governance structure
 - Input for the report will consist of: 1) input from roundtable discussions (primary source), 2) collected research reports/white papers submitted by members, and 3) knowledge of independent experts
 - After each roundtable discussion meeting minutes will be shared with the members – they will serve as an input for the report
 - The roundtable discussions will be attended by corporate partners, labor organizers, associations, advocacy groups, knowledge partners such as research organizations and at least one independent expert, who will be responsible for report writing
 - Decision still needs to be made whether a single organization will be asked to chair a work stream or knowledge partners will chair discussions on rotating basis
- Onboarding of new project members
 - Members agree that we will allow onboarding of new partners up to the second project meeting
 - It was discussed whether we should create a new category for ‘supporters’, who would endorse the activities of the group and sign off but not actively participate in discussions or make a financial contribution. Pros: more members give more power, more diversity, more impact. Cons: purpose is active involvement and negotiation of positions, which would not be achieved in this way; it is unclear how the ‘supporters’ would use the report for their purposes; might not be fair to those members who contributed with time or resources.
 - It was decided that we will reevaluate the above in four-weeks time when the new partners have been onboarded and when we will have a clearer idea of the diversity and cross-sectorial representation
- Additional activities
 - It would be very important to disseminate the final report to a wide-reaching audience, including key political bodies.
 - It was discussed that shall the additional funds become available (from new members joining) an event will be organized in Brussels in January (tentatively) and preferably in a physical setting shall the circumstances allow for it. Alternatively, an online event can be organized.
